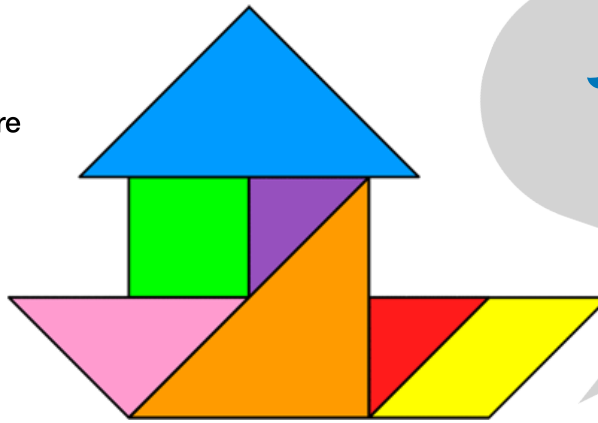




TANGRAMS: Investigating shape and solving problems

A Tangram is a Chinese puzzle consisting of a square cut into seven pieces which can be arranged to make various other shapes.

One of the main benefits of tangrams is the ability to manipulate the pieces; to "play" with the shapes and get a feel for the challenge.

This activity will bring together children's knowledge of the properties of 2d

Look carefully at the how the picture of the ship has been made

- 1. How many 'tangrams' do you think have been used to make this ship?**
- 2. Cut out the shapes and try to rearrange to make the same picture**
- 3. Now use the pieces to make 2 separate 'Tangram' squares**
- 4. Can you make a ship from each 'Tangram'?**

Challenge

Start with a square. Cut it into 7 shapes.

Arrange your shapes to make a ship.
